A mix of 40 learning activities, reflections, stories and music for children, families and young people to take us through Lent to Easter Day.

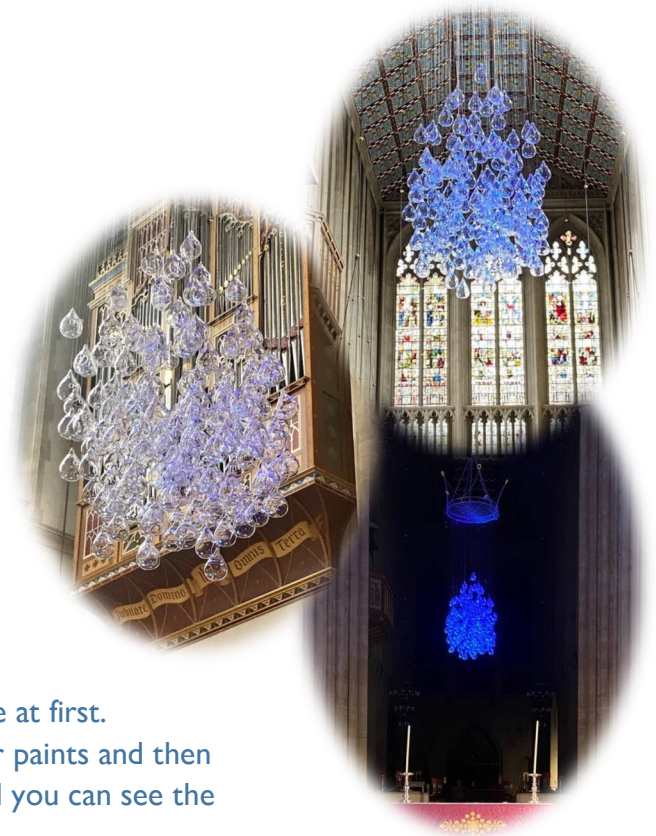
Magic Candle Art

1. Use an old candle stub to draw a teardrop or many teardrops onto your paper or card. This will look like an 'invisible' picture at first.
2. Lightly paint your picture using watercolour paints and then watch as your picture magically appears and you can see the teardrops you have drawn.
