

In the grid on the back page, record the answers to the clues. All answers are numbers, which will give you three dates that are important to the Cathedral. Find the dates and then write down why they are important. You will need to search the Cathedral and may need to ask questions!

Clue 1: How many statues of Saint Edmund can you see here?

Clue 2: Count the number of doors inside the Cathedral.

Clue 3: Find the golden bird!
How many books are on it?

Clue 4: Locate the jubilee cross. How many arrows surround the cross?

Clue 5: How many angels are looking down on us? (Hint: this is two digits).

Clue 6: The Bishops and the Deans are listed here, take the last number of the year that our current Bishop began. (Note: you will need the 0 that is already in the answer grid).

Clue 7: On an easel is a picture that tells the story of Saint Edmund. Count the number of Viking helmets.

Clue 8: Count the chandeliers in the Choir (Quire) and add 2.

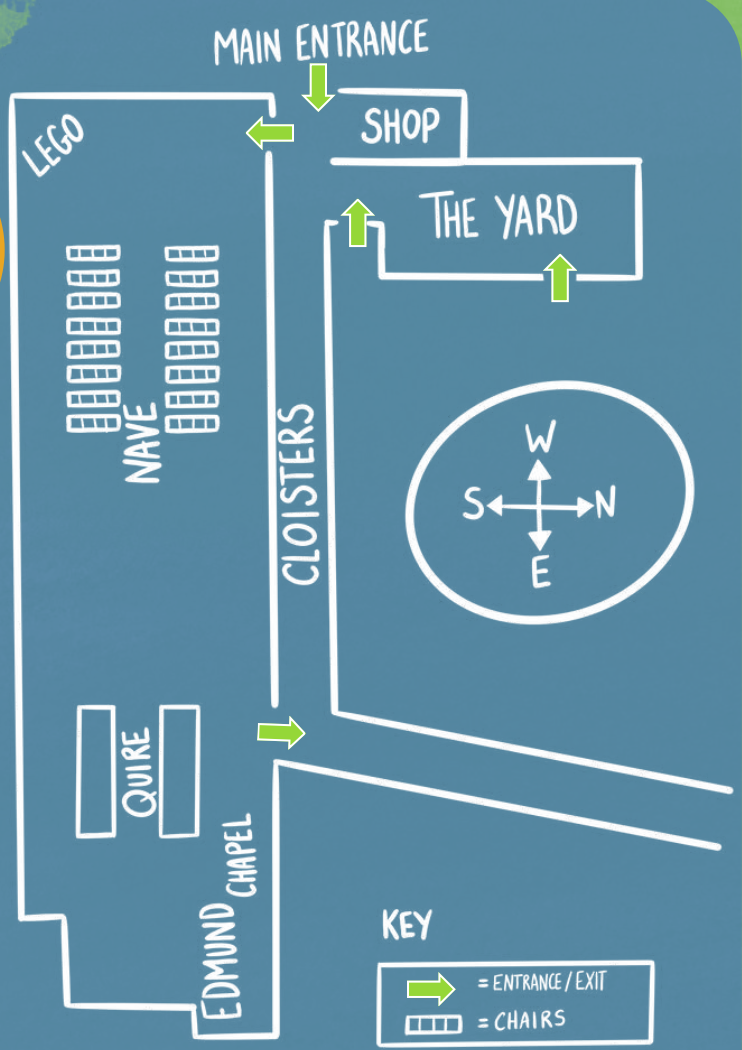
Clue 9: Around the corner from the Choir, find the flags. How many do you count?
