We sing Gloria, Gloria in excelsis, in excelsis.
Gloria, Gloria in excelsis Deo.

Jesus, blessed Lamb of God, to you our voice we raise.
You take away our sins, O Lord, receive our song of praise! Sing:

so with loudest voice sing:

The Offertory

The altar is prepared with bread and wine, and a collection is taken.

The Holy Communion

With this bread that we bring: **we remember Jesus.**
With this wine that we bring: **we remember Jesus.**
With all these gifts that we bring to God's table:
we remember Jesus.

At the beginning of the prayer over the bread and wine, we sing:

Priest The Lord be with you
All **and also with you.**
Priest Lift up your hearts.
All **We lift them to the Lord.**
Priest Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
All **It is right to give thanks and praise.**

During the prayer over the bread and wine, we sing:

Priest O Lord our God,
All **We give you thanks and praise.**

During the prayer we will sing the 'Sanctus' and 'Benedictus'

**Holy, holy, holy, God of power, God of might
all the earth and all the heavens
sing your glory day and night.
Blessed and holy; your creation,
blessed is Jesus whom you send.
Sing hosanna, sing hosanna, sing hosanna without end.**



The Lord's Prayer

Priest As Jesus taught us, so we pray:
All **Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name;
thy kingdom come; thy will be done;
on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread.
And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against us.
And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil.
For thine is the kingdom, the power and the glory,
for ever and ever. Amen.**

Priest We break this bread to share in the body of Christ.
All **Though we are many, we are one body,
because we all share in one bread.**

*If you are used to receiving Holy Communion you are welcome to receive here today.
After the distribution of Communion, the following prayer is said by everyone:*

**God of truth, we have seen with our eyes
and touched with our hands the bread of life;
strengthen our faith that we may grow in love for you
and for each other; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.**

The Blessing and Dismissal

Following any thanks, notices and the Blessing, our service ends with:

We sing **Be still, for the power of the Lord
is moving in this place,
he comes to cleanse and heal,
to minister his grace.
No work too hard for him,
in faith receive from him;
be still, for the power of the Lord
is moving in this place.**
