The altar is prepared with bread and wine, and a collection is taken.

I have wept for love of them. They turn away.

I will break their hearts of stone, Give them hearts for love alone.

I will speak my word to them. Whom shall I send?

I have heard you calling in the night.

I will go, Lord, if you lead me.

I will hold your people in my heart.

The Holy Communion

With this bread that we bring: we remember Jesus.

With this wine that we bring: we remember Jesus.

With all these gifts that we bring to God's table: we remember lesus.

At the beginning of the prayer over the bread and wine, we sing:

Priest Lift up your hearts.

All We lift them to the Lord.

Priest Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

All It is right to give thanks and praise.

During the prayer over the bread and wine, we sing:

Priest O Lord our God,

All We give you thanks and praise.

During the prayer we will sing the 'Sanctus' and 'Benedictus' (Wild Goose Resource)

heaven and earth are full: heaven and earth are full, are full of your glory: are full of your glory.

I have heard you calling in the night.

I will go, Lord, if you lead me.
