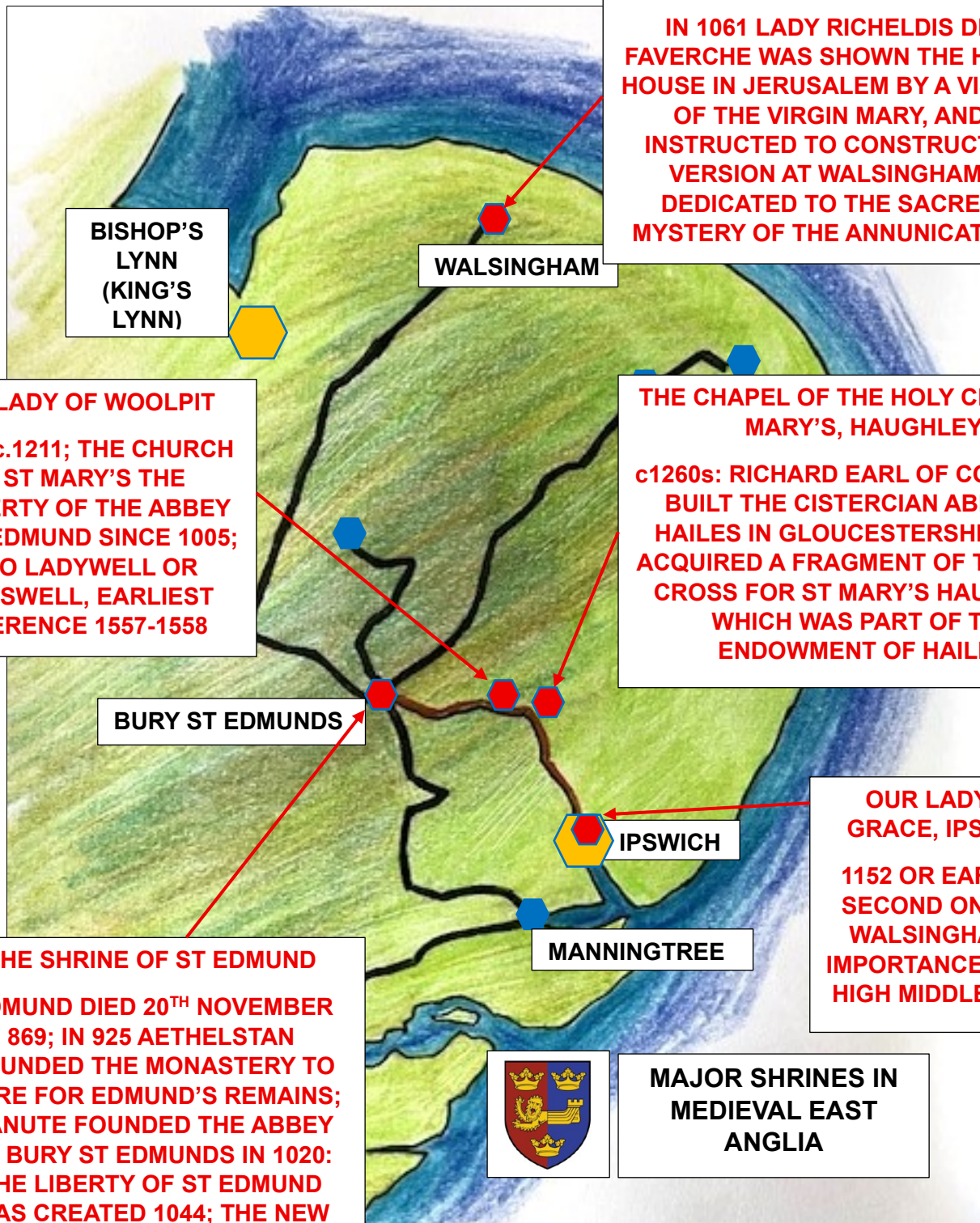




### OUR LADY OF WALSINGHAM

### THE CHAPEL OF THE HOLY CROSS, ST MARY'S, HAUGHLEY

c1260s: RICHARD EARL OF CORNWALL BUILT THE CISTERCIAN ABBEY AT HAILES IN GLOUCESTERSHIRE AND ACQUIRED A FRAGMENT OF THE TRUE CROSS FOR ST MARY'S HAUGHLEY, WHICH WAS PART OF THE ENDOWMENT OF HAILES

THE SHRINE OF ST EDMUND  
EDMUND DIED 20<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 869; IN 925 AETHELSTAN FOUNDED THE MONASTERY TO CARE FOR EDMUND'S REMAINS; CANUTE FOUNDED THE ABBEY AT BURY ST EDMUNDS IN 1020: THE LIBERTY OF ST EDMUND WAS CREATED 1044; THE NEW LARGE ABBEY CONSTRUCTED IN 1095
